Description: Cancer charities across India offer a wide array of services including gap financial funding for patients, increasing awareness against cancer, helping with early screening, cancer treatment, psychological support, rehabilitation programs, and cancer research. As we work towards improving cancer care in our regions, we recognize the importance of addressing specific challenges such as access to advanced treatments, comprehensive care strategies, and tailored rehabilitation support for patients and families.

Research plays a crucial role in enhancing patient outcomes and survival rates. However, cancer research has predominantly been led by high - income countries (HICs), which have different cancer statistics, research priorities, and infrastructure compared to us. Therefore, applying research findings from HICs to LMICs may not always yield the best results. There is an urgent need to strengthen cancer research in India that is locally relevant. Currently, efforts are mostly focused on expanding treatment facilities, with less emphasis on generating evidence specific to the region for prevention, early detection, survivorship, palliation, and access.

To address these challenges, this gathering will provide a platform for us to collaboratively brainstorm and synergize efforts to drive context-specific and solution-oriented cancer care initiatives, while also focusing on improving accessibility and affordability, for outcomes that matter. The goal is to unify our voices and efforts to help patients achieve the highest level of function and independence possible, ensuring they receive the best care both during and after treatment.
