- 2. The study should be already approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC), or be approved within 4 months from date of selection for funding and/or other regulatory approvals as required within the same timelines.

Funding and Duration:

Selected proposals will receive funding of up to INR up to 50 lakhs per year for a duration of up to 5 years. The funding can be used for study purposes, as outlined in the budget sheet approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC).

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 2. Methodology and study plan.
- 3. Potential impact.
- 4. Other criteria as decided by the selection committee.

Shortlisting Proposals:

A selection committee will review and shortlist the proposals based on the above criteria.

Presentation and Scoring:

Principal investigators of the shortlisted proposals will be called for presentation to the committee. The committee will score the proposals and recommend those for funding to Director, TMC.

Final Selection:

The Director, TMC, will review the committee's recommendations and notify the selected proposals and funding allocated.
