

- Award and free papers for encouraging young nephrology fellows



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ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The text of the Abstract should contain a maximum of 300 words. It should be structured in the following manner for original articles

- (a) Background
- (b) Aims & Objectives
- (c) Material & Methods (including statistical methods)
- (d) Results
- (e) Conclusions

For case reports/case series the authors should provide abstract as Introduction, Case description and conclusion.

Category of the paper and preferred mode of presentation should be written at the starting of abstract. Based on the scientific merit, papers will be selected for following types of presentations:

- 1) Award paper: The aim of this session is to encourage fellows, post graduates and young faculty to present research papers.
- 2) Free paper: The aim of this session is to encourage post-graduates and young faculty members to present research papers and is meant for the non-award papers only.
- 3) E-Posters: The aim of this session is to encourage post-graduates and young faculty members to present original studies, interesting case reports and case series. Best posters award will be given in three original articles and 2 best case series/case reports.
- It is mandatory for the presenting author to be registered for ISPNCON 2021.
- Presenting author should be underlined in the submitted abstract
- By submitting the abstract, it is presumed that the presenting author has the consent of his/her co-author(s) for presenting the paper in ISPNCON 2021.
- The abstract shall be reproduced in conference brochure exactly as submitted. No editing or proof reading of the submitted abstract shall be done.

Last date for abstract submission is 31st October 2021

 After the deadline for abstract submission is over, no change shall be permitted in the abstract.

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ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All accepted abstracts shall be published in the conference brochure - which may either be in hard copy or soft copy.
- All abstracts will be peer reviewed. On the basis of the consensus received from the screening committee members and the scientific committee of ISPNCON, the organizing secretary of ISPNCON 2021 shall prepare the final list of abstracts to be presented. Accepted abstracts will be listed on the conference website by 20th Nov.2021.
- Other presentation details such as allotted time, size of the poster will be conveyed in the confirmation mail of acceptance.
