## Highlights of the course

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1. Member of ISMPO
- 2. Should be the citizen of India
- 3. Age <40 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2023. A GOI-approved ID should be provided to identify oneself and as proof of birth
- 4. DM/DNB/DrNB in Medical Oncology / Pediatric oncology/Hematology OR in-training in these specialties
- 5. Brief Curriculum Vitae- 2 pages maximum (signed & dated)
- 6. Letter of Intent from the applicant 500 words describing why and how you plan to benefit from this course
- 7. Institute letter of recommendation By HOD in case of a student, by HOD of the hospital where working or HOD of the institute where trained in the case of YMO
- 8. A case presentation in PPT format (6 slides) that relates to the course's topic, in the format provided

## **Selection** Criteria

Selection will be based on the following,

- 1. Brief Curriculum Vitae
- 2. Case presentation
- 3. Strength of letter of intent

Selection will be done by the ISMPO preceptorship board-comprising at least 3 members as decided by the President, ISMPO and EIC, IJMPO

### **Facilities Offered**

- 1. Round trip economy class air travel or AC 2 tier railway tickets and ground transport up to a maximum of 24,000 INR
